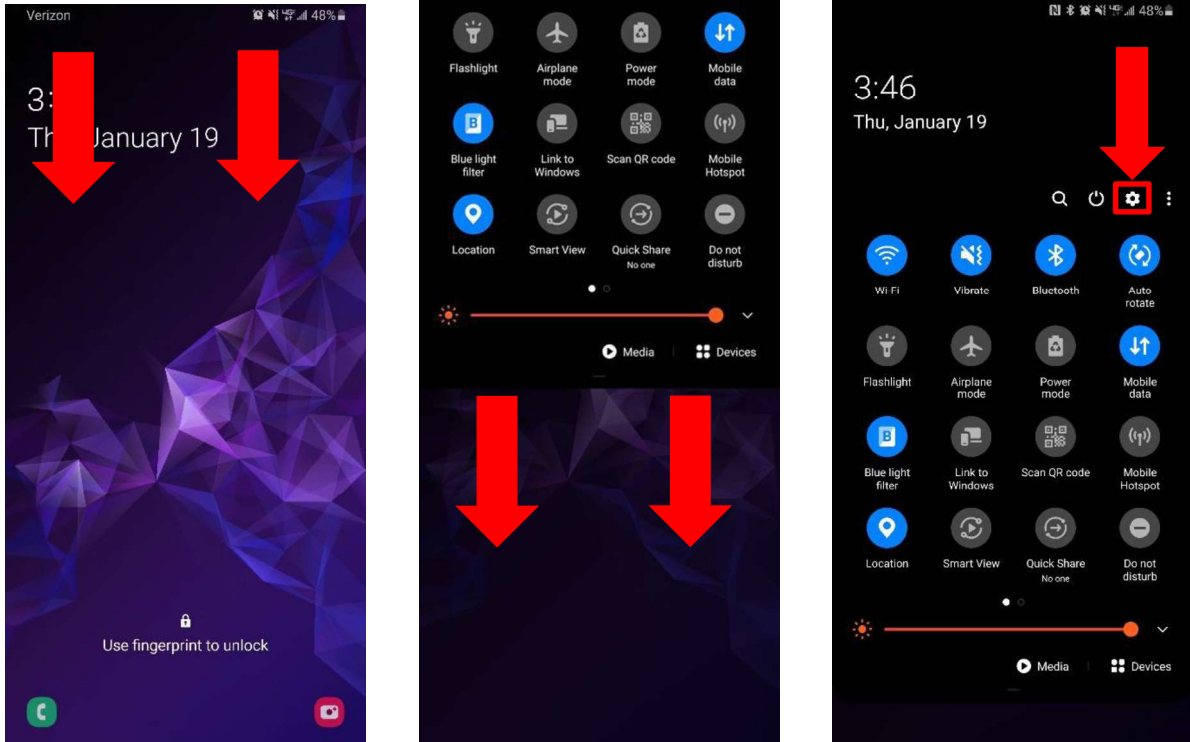


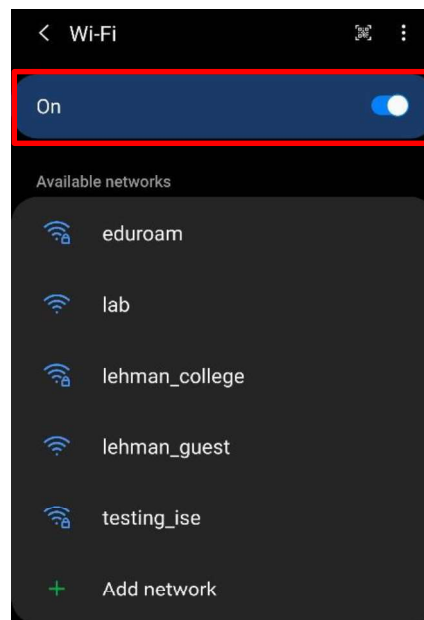
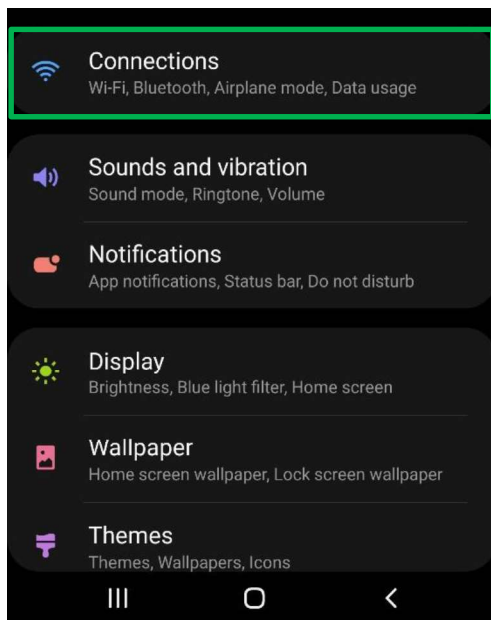
## Configuring Android enabled devices for the new wireless network

(Note: screenshots are from Samsung Galaxy S9+ with Firmware 4.0.4)

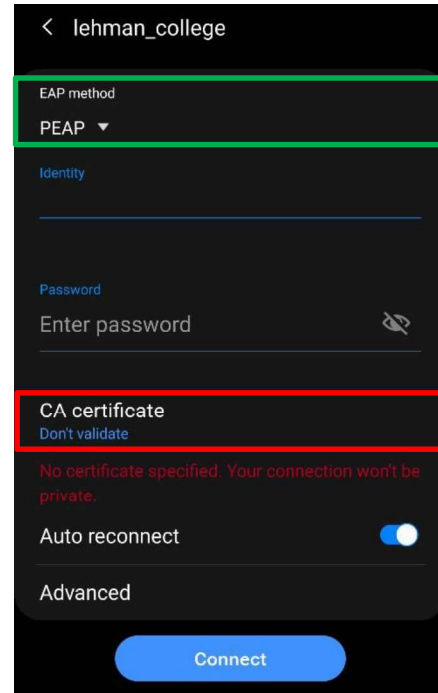
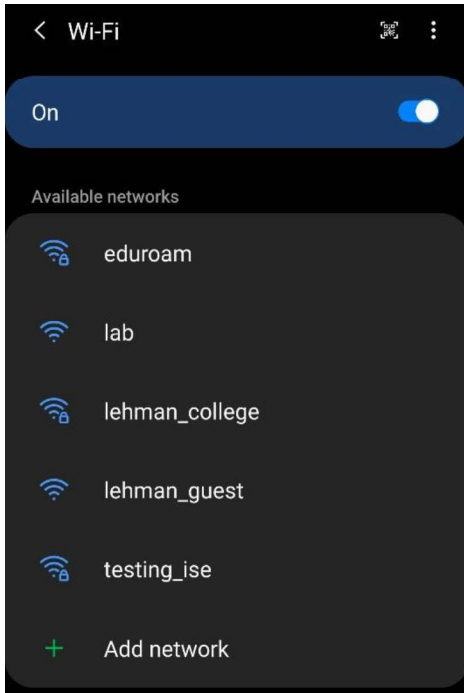
1. On the Home/Lock Screen, slide down from the top to view your Notification Panel and click the settings icon.



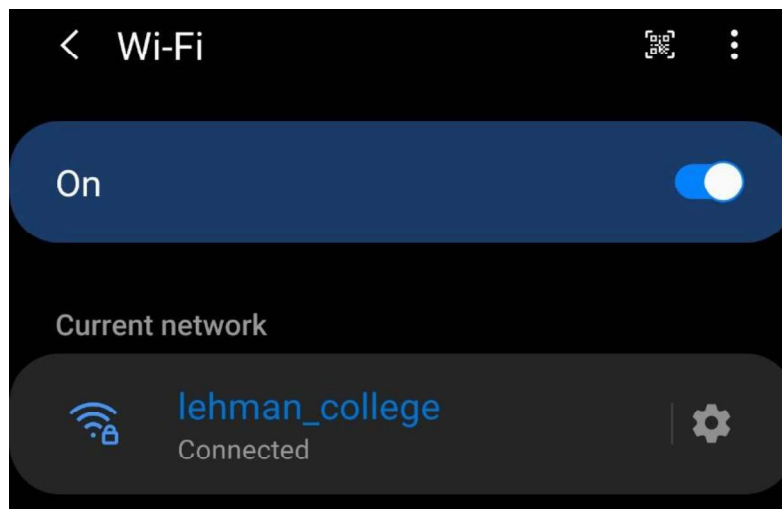
2. On the Settings screen, tap **Connections** and turn on **Wi-Fi**.



3. Tap “*lehman\_college*” and proceed to type in your Lehman 360 username and password. Be sure the **EAP method** is set to **PEAP** and the **CA certificate** is set to **Don't validate**. Press connect after all settings are done.



4. The Wi-Fi status will display your connection to the “*lehman\_college*” network



Your device is now configured to connect to “*lehman\_college*”. In the future, you may connect to “*lehman\_college*” by simply selecting it from the list of available wireless networks and providing your login credentials.
